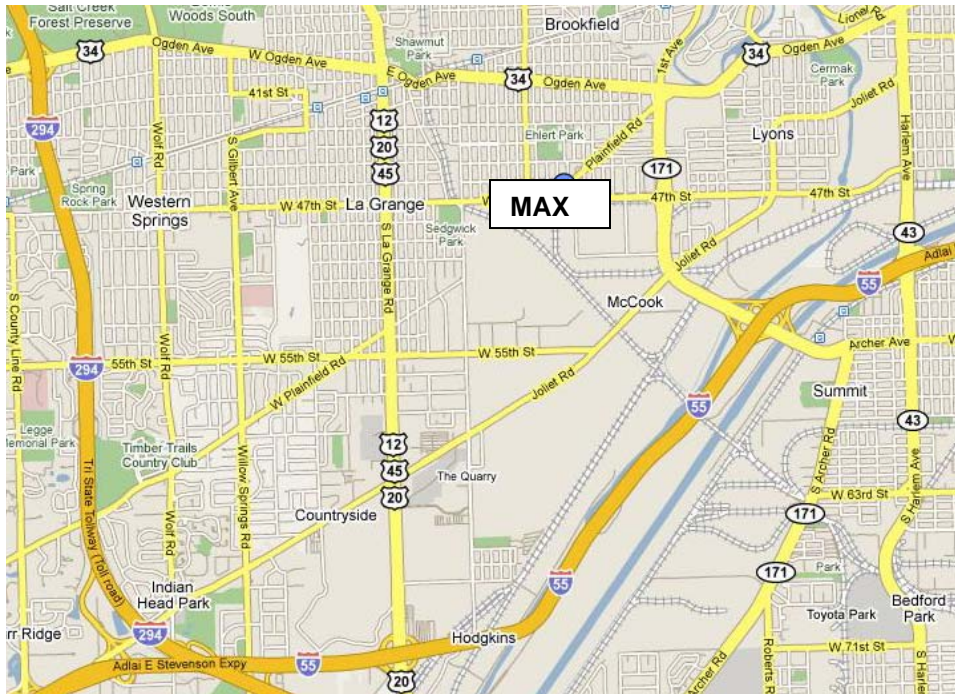

Site Information Three rings 90' X 110' - Indoors on Field Turf – Three judges. Crates, chairs etc may be left overnight. No dogs may be left overnight. The Great Lakes Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc., the Golden Retriever Club of Illinois, Inc. and McCook Athletic & Exposition Center will not be responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property.

Prizes and Awards Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to place. MACH Ribbons and bars will be awarded. All prizes must be claimed before the close of the trials. None will be mailed.

Collars At the handler's option the dog may wear a FLAT or rolled leather collar but there shall be no attachments hanging or other wise on collars. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy collars, Halties and Gentle leaders are prohibited. Food, toys and whistles or other training devices are not allowed in the course area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Gate Stewards are only following directions to keep the trial moving smoothly for all. Please treat all volunteers working this trial for you respectfully.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH (with the leash in owner's or handler's hand; not dragging on the ground) **at all times** except when in the designated Agility warm up area. Flexi leads are not recommended in crating or course area.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show site clean.

Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs will be excused from the trial with no monies refunded.

Catalogs Pre-order - \$7.50 each. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the site - \$10.00 each. Running Order sheets will be available free of charge to all exhibitors.

Course familiarization and Warm-Ups Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class as directed by the judge to plan their strategy. Judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. A warm up jump will be provided for each ring.

Card sized photocopies of Official AKC jump height cards will be accepted with entries and will speed up your check in at the trial. If you do not send or present a valid height card at the trial you **MUST** be measured before you can run.

STD, JWW and F.A.S.T. Classes offered as described in Chapter 2, Section 1, “Classes” in the Agility Regulations. Electronic timers will be used at this event.

Dogs Eligible to enter This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing Program/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) (effective 2/1/08), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds which are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the registration and discipline rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

No more than 10 entries allowed per envelope No online entries will be accepted. Express Mail entries (although not necessary) must waive “acceptance signature requirement”. Entry form changes, corrections or cancellations must be done in writing before the **July 8, 2009** closing date. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms. Entries must include the AKC agreement.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs without a valid height card.

Dogs **may not** enter both **Regular** and **Preferred** classes for the same set of trials for the weekend.
