Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST** be received in **writing** prior to the May 13 closing date, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted. Email changes are welcomed. No refunds for duplicate entries or entry form errors.

Entries can be made via fax or email with payment made via PayPal or credit card. Fax entries are to be sent to 206-222-2830. Entries not on official herding entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms, without the Release Form on the reverse side of the entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from the competition by actions of the Trial Committee. Refunds of entries pulled after closing date will be made as long as an alternate runs: if no alternate runs, no refund will be given. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire or Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Bitches in season will run in catalog order.

**For Exhibition Only trial entries will be accepted** if entry limits are not reached. FEO entries will be \$25 each. Scores will not be recorded and will not count toward AKC herding titles.

**From Chicago/east:** I-90 west to IL Hwy 47. Go north to Hwy 14. Go west (left) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front). Follow gravel drive to barn area for parking.

**From Milwaukee/northeast:** I-43 south to Hwy 120. Go south on 120 - it becomes Hwy 47 at the IL state line. Follow Hwy 47 through Woodstock to Hwy 14. Go west (right) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front). Follow gravel drive to barn area for parking.

**From MN/northwest:** I-90 east to US Hwy 20, go east to IL Hwy 47. North (left) on 47 to Hwy 14. Go west (left) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front). Follow gravel drive to barn area for parking.

**SITE INFORMATION:** This event is being held at a private residence. **Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs and themselves!** Please bring your own chairs and shade tents/screens as there is little shade available. Morning coffee/snacks will be available; donations are appreciated. Lunch will be available for workers. Lunch availability for non-working exhibitors will be determined and made available in the judging program.

Dogs **MUST** be confined in vehicles or crated. Crates/ex-pens need to be placed only in the areas designated by the Trial Committee. Dogs should be leashed when not in the arena.

All sheep trial classes will be in a 105'x210' arena. A course duck classes will be in a 50'x100' arena. B course outruns will be minimum distances.

If there are Alternate entries, all alternates must report to the Trial Secretary before the start of the day's classes. If you do not, your spot may be given to an alternate in an earlier class.

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## Joyce Norris Duck Clinic Friday May 26th

Joyce Norris has been herding since 1996 and has been raising & working with ducks for 11 years. She has held many excellent duck herding seminars and clinics. This special one-day clinic will help you get ready for the weekend trial and further your duck herding education.

Joyce is supplying the ducks for the weekend trial and will have extra ducks for the clinic. She will be working on both A course & B course, and will work at whatever level the handler wishes to work with their dog. This is a great opportunity to work ducks with the "Duck Lady" and get tips that can help increase your trial success.

Working spots in the clinic are \$75 per dog and auditing spots are \$45. Lunch is included. The clinic will begin at 8:30am at Wooden Ewe Ranch, the site of the weekend trial. There is limited availability so get your entries in early.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

**I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering; i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collie (rough, smooth); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles).

2. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
